AKA CRAVOVIENNE QUICKSTEP, CICADIAN QUICKSTEP



THE KRAKOWIAK OR CRACOVIENNE IS A FAST, SYNCOPATED POLISH FOLK DANCE IN DUPLE TIME FROM THE REGION OF KRAKOW THE FOLK OUTFIT WORN FOR THE DANCE HAS BECOME THE NATIONAL COSTUME OF POLAND (WIKIPEDIA). THE DANCE IS SAID TO IMITATE THE MOVEMENT OF HORSES (EDUCALINGO DICTIONARY).

This tune appears in the Musician's Omnibus compiled and published by Elias Howe in 1863, Boston, MA. and in an earlier publication by Howe called the Musicians Companion, published in 1850.
